Directions from Thief River Falls: go 12 miles north on highway 32 and 11 miles east on Marshall County Road 7.

Habitat: Large pools; marshes; grassland; brushland bog; aspen woodland.

Features: Agassiz's 61,500 acres are a haven for many wildlife species. A Globally Important Bird Area, the refuge supports over 280 species of birds - 7,500 pairs of nesting ducks, 20,000 pairs of Franklin's gulls and four pairs of bald eagles. There are numerous species of mammals including moose, deer, eastern gray wolves, amphibians and reptiles. The refuge provides foot trails, a self-guided automobile route, an observation tower, and an observation desk, all of which provide great opportunities to observe wildlife! Wildlife displays and a book shop are in the office.

Best Times to Visit: April through November.

Notes: Refuge Office open 7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Auto tour route open May - October.
