- **Teddy Dorn Nursing Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is enrolled in a nursing program on full-time basis. An initial sum of \$250 will be paid directly to the school the first semester and an additional \$250 will be paid if the recipient continues in the program for the second semester. A past recipient may apply for an additional scholarship to a \$1,000 maximum including the initial scholarship.
- **Don L. Olson Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is a member of the National Honor Society, must have lettered in at least one sport and is in good standing in school. \$100 is awarded directly to the student.
- **Web Maves Family Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is a member of a single parent household (preference to student with a deceased parent); must be accepted at a technical school, 2-year or 4-year college; must demonstrate the ability to accomplish their state educational goals and who is in good standing at school. \$500 is paid directly to the school second semester.
- **MeriJo Paschke Educational Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be majoring in education with preference given to individual who will enter the Media Specialist field, must have GPA of "B" or above, must demonstrate character, leadership and community service and be accepted at a 2-year or 4-year college. \$150 is paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Carl and Melva Lee Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be majoring in business, must have a GPA of at least 3.5, must be in good standing at school, and is active in extracurricular activities. \$500 is paid directly to the school first semester.
- **Fred Jensen Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is accepted at a technical school, 2-year or 4-year college, majoring in Sales and Marketing or Retail Merchandising, and must demonstrate a financial need. \$500 is paid directly to the school first semester.
- **David Lee Johnson Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School hockey player who has lettered in hockey at Lincoln High School, and will continue their education next fall. Two letters of recommendation must also be submitted from classroom teachers with their insights and comments on the level of effort and character displayed by the student in their classroom. \$500 is paid directly to the school first semester.
- **Sami Haj Business Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be majoring in Business with a preference to Restaurant/Motel Management, must have a GPA of at least 3.0, must be in good standing at school, must be active in extracurricular activities and demonstrates after-school and community involvement. \$500 is paid directly to the school second semester.

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- **Thora Skomedal Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be seeking a Bachelor of Science in English and must in a well-organized single-page essay, discuss and support your reason(s) for pursuing a career in English education, your goals, and how you plan to accomplish those goals. \$100 is paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Loren “Bones” Stadum Athletic Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is accepted at an accredited college, must maintain a “B” average, and has participated in athletic sports with preference to basketball. \$500 is paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Frances E. Eide Memorial Nursing Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is enrolled in a nursing program on a full-time basis, must indicate financial need, and must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA or above. Two \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded with \$1,000 paid directly to the school first semester and an additional \$1,000 paid if the recipient continues in the program for the second semester.
- **Tony Dorn Sr. Student Athlete Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who has a GPA of at least 3.0, must be in good standing at school and be active in extracurricular activities. \$500 is paid directly to the school first semester.
- **Ted Hellie Teaching Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is accepted at an accredited college and must obtain a teaching degree. \$500 is paid directly to the school first semester.
- **Alice and Roy Lee Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who has lettered in a sport at Lincoln High School, must have maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better, and will attend any college in Minnesota or North Dakota. \$500 is paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Hempel Fine Arts Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be pursuing a Fine Arts Degree, must show employment history along with community and extracurricular activity, must show financial need, must be enrolled in or have been enrolled in the Magnet Arts program at LHS, must be currently enrolled in at least one class in either dance, music, theatre, visual arts or literary arts, and must have two letters of reference, one of which should be from a teacher in the area of study relevant to the scholarship. \$200 will be paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Lincoln High School Class of 1977 Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be attending Northland Community and Technical College/Thief River Falls Campus as a full-time student. Applicant must write a detailed 300-500 word essay on how growing up in our community and attending Lincoln High School has influenced your life. \$500 will be paid directly to NCTC/TRF Campus second semester.
- **Prowler Boys Basketball Alumni Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who has a GPA of at least 3.0, must be in good standing at school, and a letter winner for Boys Basketball (Managers included). Award will be paid directly to student first semester.
- **Cliff Swanson Memorial Business Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be majoring in Business, must be active in athletic extracurricular activities and must demonstrate financial need. \$200 will be paid directly to the school second semester.
- **Dr. George T. VanRooy Memorial Nursing Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is enrolled in a nursing program full-time and has a GPA of “B” or above. Two scholarships will be awarded. \$250 will be paid directly to the schools second semester.

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— **Ruth Stenson Memorial Vocal Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who is a choir student at Lincoln High School, must be enrolled in a 4-year college majoring in vocal music (teaching or performance), must be taking private voice lessons from a vocal coach, must write a two-page paper describing how music has influenced his/her life and financial background does not matter. \$300 will be paid directly to the school second semester.

— **Michael Holmer Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be attending a Tech School studying automotive repair/mechanics and must have maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better. \$500 will be paid directly to the school second semester.

— **Dorothy M. Olson Memorial Scholarship:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who will be majoring in music and has maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better. Three scholarships will be awarded. \$500 will be paid directly to the school second semester.

— **Jennifer and Jolyn Vigen “Special Education” Award:** Must be a Lincoln High School graduate who has financial need, must have maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better, must be pursuing a degree in the special education field, and emphasis will also be placed on moral character and a demonstrated commitment to helping individuals with developmental disabilities. \$500 will be paid directly to the school second semester.

N. Quentin and Elizabeth McBride Jones Athletic Perseverance Award: Student must be nominated by a coach, must demonstrate academic success, must have competed in an individual sport during their 11th and 12th grade years (tennis, golf, swimming, cross country, track & field, or wrestling), must be accepted into a post-secondary education institution and must be a Lincoln High School graduate. \$500 will be paid directly to the school first semester.

Ralph Skay Memorial Award: Student must be nominated by a coach, must demonstrate academic success, must have competed in baseball or football, must be accepted into a post-secondary education institution and must be a Lincoln High School graduate. Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded: one in baseball and one in football, paid directly to the school second semester.
